By Bus



The Palace, Park and Gardens are open daily from Saturday 14th February to Sunday 20th December 2015.

Park: 09.00 - 18.00

Formal Gardens: 10.00 - 17.30

Palace: 10.30 - 17.30 with 16.45 last entry.

During the Palace closed season, the Park remains open except for Christmas Day, from 09.00 until 16.45 or dusk if earlier.




